	<p>The Cambridge Online Preliminary Application (COPA) must be completed by anyone applying from outside the EU (this includes those applying from Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway and Switzerland). If this applies to you and you have not yet submitted a COPA, you should do so soon as possible and by 18:00 UK time on Thursday 19 October.</p> <p><i>Applicants applying from outside the EU</i></p>
	<p>If you are unable to provide a digital photograph as part of the online Supplementary Application Questionnaire (SAQ), you should complete and return the Applicant Photograph Submission Form by Thursday 19 October at the very latest.</p> <p><i>If applicable</i></p>
	<p>Return your signed Data Protection Consent Form in the post by Wednesday 8 November. <u>Electronic copies are not acceptable.</u></p> <p><i>All applicants</i></p>
	<p>Send a photocopy of your passport page. If you do not have a passport, please send a photocopy of your birth certificate. The copy does not have to be attested.</p> <p><i>All applicants</i></p>
	<p>Send the Admissions Administrator any written work that is required for your subject (please refer to the Pre-interview and Interview Notes for Applicants document) by Wednesday 8 November. This applies to all applicants, including those who have requested an overseas interview. For each piece of work submitted, please use a separate cover sheet. Please send your written work in the post. <u>Electronic copies are not acceptable.</u></p> <p><i>If applicable</i></p>
	<p>If you are taking, or have taken, modular AS and A levels, post evidence of the UMS and/or raw scores you have achieved (such as a Statement of Results) to the Admissions Administrator by Wednesday 8 November at the latest. We will place this on your file so please send a photocopy which we may keep. Please ensure that your name is clearly printed on the document and write your UCAS Personal ID number and the subject you have applied to study at the top.</p> <p><i>If applicable. If you are not taking modular A levels, no action is necessary.</i></p>
	<p>If you have declared a disability/specific learning difficulty and require any Adjustments/Allowances at Interview, please return the Request for Adjustments/Allowances at Interview form by Wednesday 8 November. Please send your form in the post. <u>Electronic copies are not acceptable.</u></p> <p><i>If applicable</i></p>
